These changes also apply to the transcripts of the two lectures.

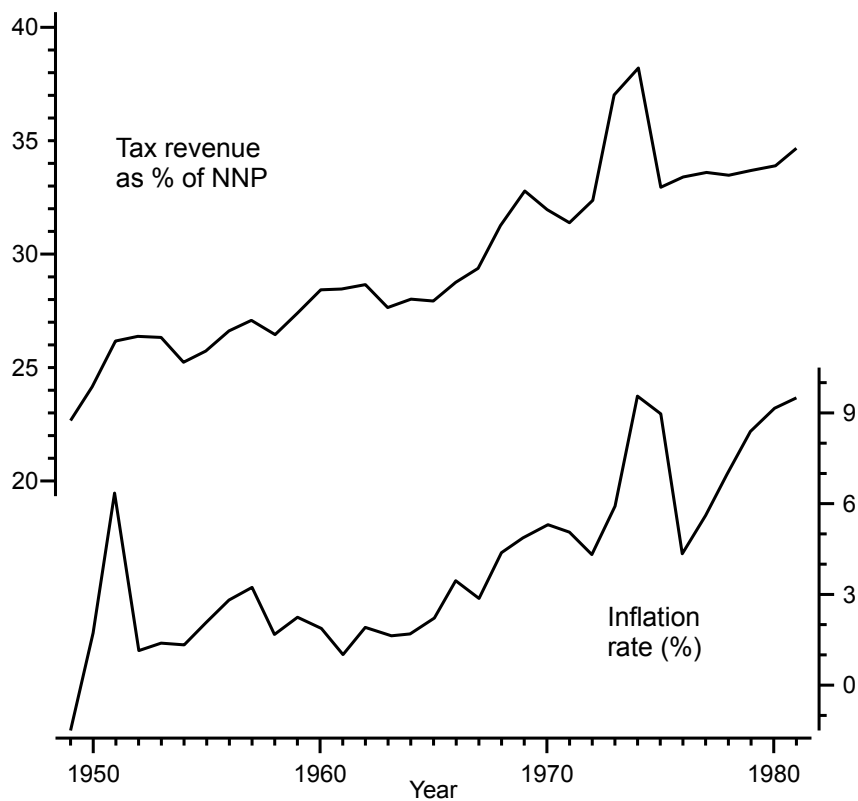


Figure 1: Tax revenue and inflation rate, U.S.A.

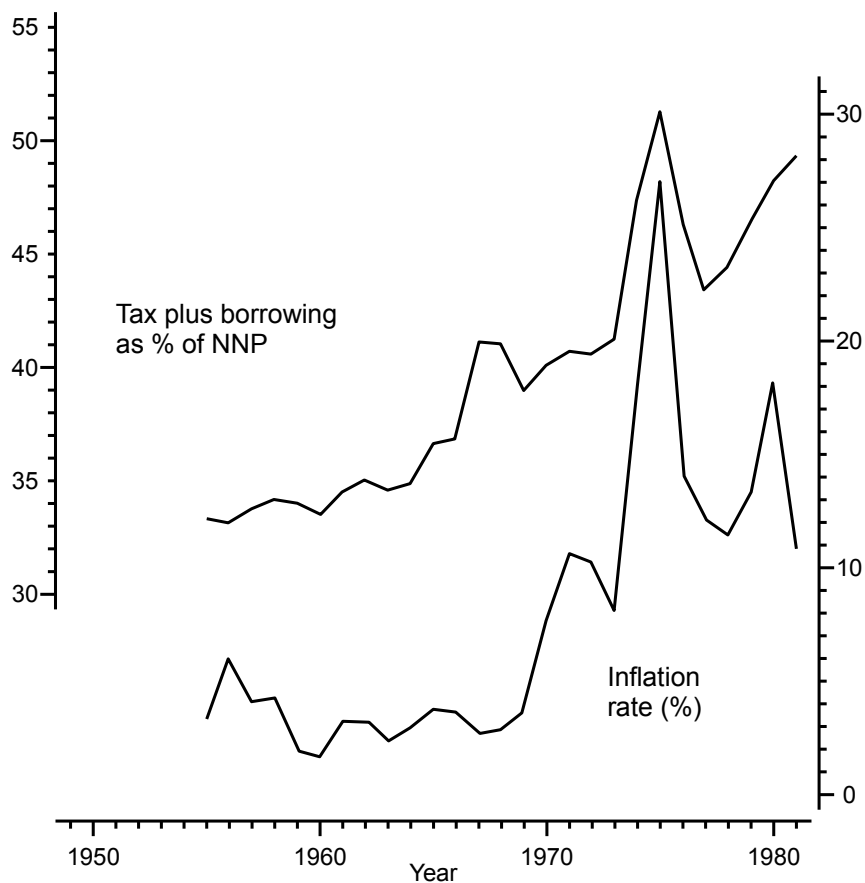


Figure 2: Tax plus borrowing and inflation rate, U.K.

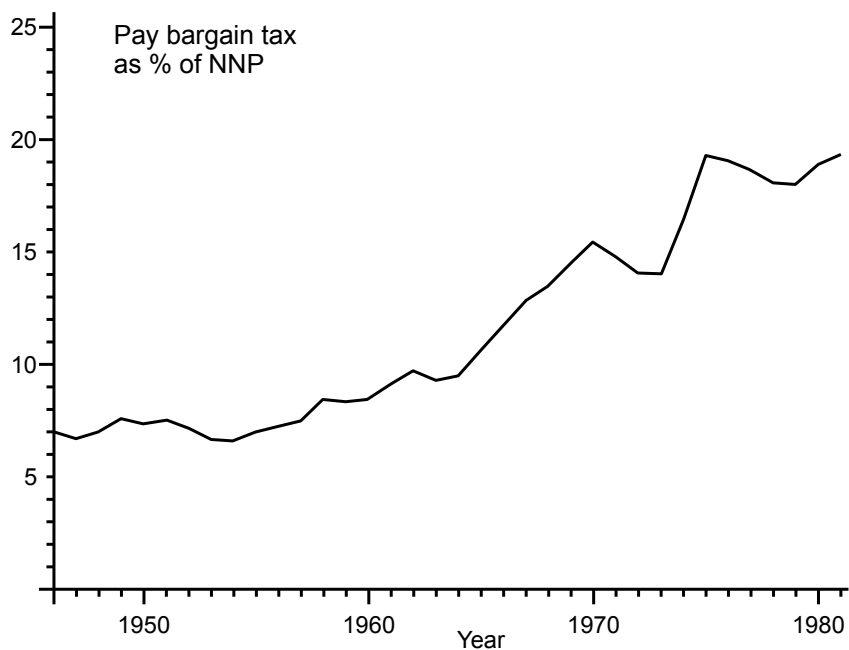


Figure 1: Pay bargain tax as % of NNP

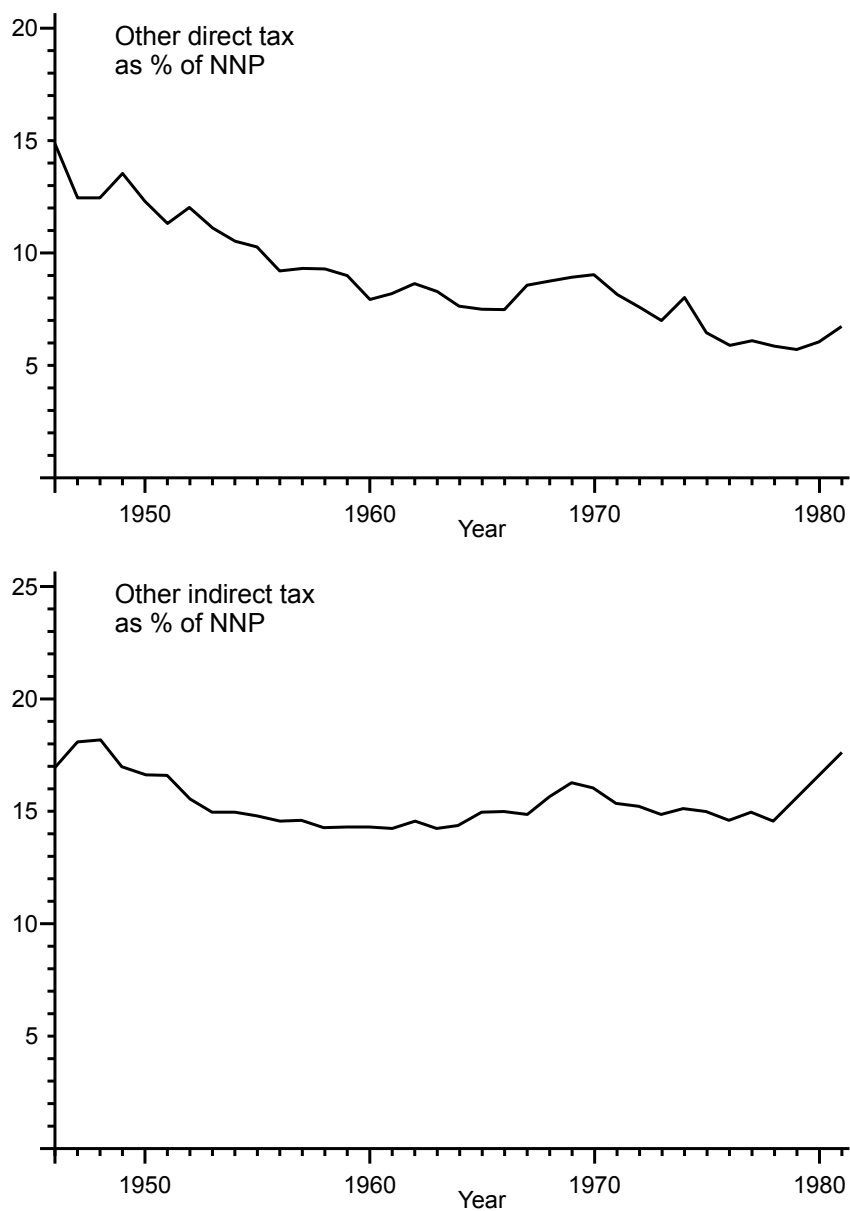


Figure 2: Other taxes as % of NNP
